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4. First Aid Measures

Eye Contact	Rinse cautiously with water for at least 15 minutes, holding eyelids open. Remove contact lenses if present. Get medical advice if irritation persists.
Skin Contact	Take off contaminated clothing. Wash skin with plenty of water and soap. Get medical advice if a rash or irritation develops.
Inhalation	Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice if symptoms persist.
Ingestion	Rinse mouth with water. Do NOT induce vomiting (aspiration hazard — may be fatal if it enters the airways). Immediately seek medical attention.

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5. Firefighting Measures

Firefighting

Flammable liquid and vapour; vapours may travel to an ignition source and flash back. Suitable extinguishing media: alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical powder, carbon dioxide (CO₂) or water fog. Do not use a heavy/direct water jet. Requires SCBA and full protective clothing.

6. Accidental Release Measures

Accidental Release

Eliminate ignition sources, ensure adequate ventilation, wear gloves and eye protection. Contain and absorb the spill with inert material (sand, vermiculite) and collect into a closed container for disposal. Do not use sparking tools. Prevent entry into drains, waterways and soil.

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7. Handling & Storage

Storage Conditions	5 – 35 °C
Handling Precautions	1. Shake well before use. 2. Apply onto a microfiber cloth or directly onto the surface. 3. Spread evenly over the surface. 4. Wipe with regular strokes until the natural shine is restored. 5. Buff with a clean, dry microfiber cloth for best results.

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10. Stability & Reactivity

Stability & Reactivity

Stable under normal storage and handling conditions. Avoid heat, sparks, open flame, direct sunlight and static discharge. Incompatible with strong oxidizing agents. Combustion produces carbon oxides. Handling: use only in well-ventilated areas away from heat, sparks and open flame. No smoking. Avoid breathing spray and skin/eye contact. Use non-sparking, grounded equipment.

11. Toxicological Information

Toxicology

No experimental toxicological data available for this product. Repeated exposure may cause skin dryness or cracking (EUH066). May cause temporary eye discomfort. Aspiration hazard if swallowed (H304). May cause drowsiness or dizziness (H336).

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12. Ecological Information

Ecology

Toxic to aquatic life with long lasting effects (H411, from n-pentane). No biodegradability data available for the mixture. Product is insoluble in water — prevent release into drains, soil and watercourses.

Disposal
